



Emergency Childcare Assistance Update

If you are a family in need of childcare assistance, please review the following temporary changes for Employment Related Day Care which began Monday, March 16, 2020 and continue for the duration of the Governor’s declared state of emergency period: **There is no copay – copays have been reduced to \$0.00**

- If a family has already paid their copay, they can arrange reimbursement privately with their childcare provider.
- **The income limit has increased for initial eligibility** and now is the same as the ongoing and exit limit amount: (Employment Related Day Care)

These changes have raised the income limit significantly during the emergency period and those that did not previous qualify for childcare assistance may now qualify
